Venue: Research talks and lectures will take place in Room 505 on the 5th floor of the *UCLU Building, 25 Gordon Street*, in which the Dept. of Mathematics is situated. Registration, coffee breaks, refreshments and the reception will take place in Room 502 on the same floor. There are three elevators in the building, please use one of the double elevators as the single one does not serve floors 5 and above. The building, as well as the staircase above floor 4, are locked after approx. 18:00.

Transport: The nearest tube stations are *Euston Square* (Circle, Metropolitan and Hammersmith & City), *Euston Station* (Northern, Victoria and national rail services) and *Warren Street* (Northern and Victoria). There are bus stops serving several lines close by as well. The smart phone app “Citymapper” is essential to finding your way through London’s extensive public transport network. For cheaper fares, we recommend buying an “Oyster Card,” a smart card which you can top up and use on the tube, buses (no cash accepted!), overground and more. The Oyster card is free apart from a 5£ deposit.

The Imperial Hotel is at 61–66 Russell Sq, close to *Russell Square* station (Picadilly). It is situated a 12min walk from the Dept. of Mathematics.

IT Services: WiFi is available either by using eduroam (with your usual credentials) or by connecting to the network “UCLGuest.” When connecting to eduroam, you might have to install and trust a certain certificate. (More information can be found at www.ucl.ac.uk/isd/services/get-connected/wireless/certificate-update)

If you need something printed, feel free to approach one of the local organisers.

Restaurants and Cafés: There are many restaurants, take aways, cafés and pubs on Tottenham Court Rd, at Euston Station and near UCL. There is a Sainsbury’s supermarket at 145 Tottenham Court Road and a student café on the ground floor of 25 Gordon St. On Thursday, there is a Farmer’s Market with many excellent food stalls on Torrington Sq.
